California State University, Northridge

- State supported 6 year university.
- Over 35,000 students, with more than 50% Pell Grant eligible, and almost 50% URMs.
- Most students are commuters.
- Located within the city limits of Los Angeles.
- One of the 20 largest institutions of this type in the country.





- 23 campuses and is the largest University System in the country.
- The CA Master Educational Plan: RSCA is authorized in the CSUs and shall be supported by the State.
- \$641mi in G&C Expenditures with \$351mi in R&D and \$60mi in Institutional Support in FY 2010/11.
- Most Funded:

San Diego State University San Jose State University Sacramento State San Francisco State University Fresno State University CSUN with ~ \$33mi in FY 2011/2012.

External Funding at CSUN

College of Science and Math: ~ \$10mi in FY 2011/12.

- \$ 2.4mi in Training Grants.
- \$ 2.1mi in NIH grants
- Grants from Army, ONR, DOE, NASA, etc.
- **\$1.7mi** from PREM PIs (including the PREM Grant)

CSM is the most funded followed by the College of Education with **~\$8.5mi** in FY 2011/12, most from USDE.

Support for Research at CSUN

- Large Grant Policy: Significantly reduces PIs teaching load.
- Expanded Startup Packages in CSM.
- Redefinition of CSUN University Space for Research with significant

renovations of research space in CSM.

• Enhanced library access to Electronic Journals, IT equipment and

Software to support research.

Support for Research at CSUN

•Seed Money: \$250K in mini-grants or reassigned time.

•Support for applying for External Funding: \$200K in additional summer pay or reassigned time.

•GRIF: A CSU policy to increase PI's salary up to 35% for PI's who bring more than \$500K per year.

•Support for PREM PI's to hire **Post-doctoral Fellows** and **International Graduate Students**.

•**Reassigned time** for the PREM PI to manage the grant.

MOTIVATION

- Increase External Funding and double the amount of sponsored research at CSUN in the next 5 to 7 years.
- PREM PI's are among the top funded faculty on campus.
- PREM PI's promote Interdisciplinary Research.
- PREM engages students in Mentored Research, an activity nationally recognized as a high-impact practice.
- The program will be instrumental in developing a joint PhD program in Physics at CSUN.
